The International Conference "DISCRETE MATHEMATICS, ALGEBRA AND THEIR APPLICATIONS" (DIMA-2015) will be held in Minsk, Belarus, on September 14-18, 2015. The Conference is dedicated to the 100th anniversary of Dmitrii Alexeevich Suprunenko. The first Conference with a similar title took place in Minsk in 2009.

- Algebra and algebraic geometry:
 - Structure of algebraic groups and simple algebras;
 - Permutation groups;
 - Linear groups and representations.
- Discrete mathematics and mathematical cybernetics:

 - Discrete optimization;
 - Algorithms, data structures and computation complexity;
 - Applications of discrete mathematics in computer science, operation research, algebra, topology, and probability theory.

The conference programme includes:

- invited plenary 45-minute lectures and
- contributed 25-minute talks in several parallel sections.

The working languages of the Conference are Russian and English.
